Meaning Through Mitzvot

B'nai Mitzvah Giving Opportunities

\$75 CARE PACKAGE FOR ONE SOLDIER

Graduates serving in the military without family in Israel receive care packages from the Village.

\$250 SCHOOL CLOTHES, SHOES and SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Children without families need clothes, shoes and school supplies to attend school.

\$360 SPORTS EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

Sneakers, uniforms and more are needed for the children to participate in a wide range of sports activities, from soccer and basketball to swimming, running and aerobics.

\$500 ART, MUSIC & THEATER ENRICHMENT

Cultural arts enrich the lives of the children. Visits to the theater, arts/crafts supplies, music lessons and choir practice and performances are popular activities.

\$800 SUMMER CAMP

Each summer, Yemin Orde hosts young at-risk children from Israel for a special summer camp at the Village.

\$1,800 TRAVEL ABROAD FOR FAMILY VISITS

Small groups of children travel abroad each summer to visit their families.

\$1,800 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR GRADUATES

Need-based scholarships are awarded to graduates to attend university or pursue higher education.

\$1,800 FIELD TRIPS

Children visit Jerusalem to see historic sites and experience Israel's living history.

\$1,800 THERAPY/COUNSELING FOR ONE CHILD/YEAR

Children can heal from past trauma with special therapies such as art and music as well as conventional psychological care. Intensive therapy is available for children with greater challenges or special needs.

\$2,000 ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT

Yemin Orde provides care to approximately 22 students each year who suffer extreme orthodontic problems.

\$3,600 LIBRARY BOOKS

The Village's library was burned to the ground and all its books were destroyed. In addition to new books, we need tables, chairs, lamps and more.

\$3,600 MEMORY BOOK PROGRAM FOR NINTH GRADERS

Ninth graders receive memory books to fill with photos and mementoes of their experiences in the Village. This program helps the children connect to their past and have special memories for safekeeping.

\$5,000 COMPUTER CENTER

The Village supports a modern computer center with 100 computers. New software and maintenance are needed on an ongoing basis. Partial gifts to help fund items in this center are welcome.

\$7,200 WATER DISPENSERS

Important for the health and well-being of youth in their homes.

\$9,600 CAMPING EQUIPMENT

On special camping trips, the children learn to pitch tents, cook outside and safely hike in the country. Partial gifts to help fund items such as tents or sleeping bags are welcome.

\$18,000 ETGAR HIKE PROGRAM FOR SENIOR CLASS

Each fall, high school seniors embark on a three-day Etgar or challenge hike. This hike builds confidence, friendships, team spirit, and cooperation. After the hike, the seniors feel accomplished and that they truly "belong" to the Land of Israel.

\$20,000: MENTOR

There are 22 informal educators who serve as mentors in the Village and who provide exceptional guidance and help the children achieve success. A \$20,000 gift will pay the salary for one mentor for the children.

WALL OF HONOR

Child's name will be included in the Village's Wall of Honor for B'nai Mitzvah gifts that exceed \$1,800. We can custom design a giving opportunity for gifts over \$18,000.
